Resolution on China

Adopted at the Danish Communist Party's Congress in Copenhagen, March 16, 2024

- 1. The Chinese People's Revolution of 1949 was one of the most important revolutionary events of the 20th century. It was first and foremost an anti-colonial revolution that united national liberation with social liberation. After more than 100 years of imperialist plunder, oppression and degradation, the revolution gave the Chinese peasants and workers the opportunity to become masters of their own house.
- 2. The People's Revolution has seen the Chinese people take a giant leap out of poverty and colonial oppression. Within a few decades, progress has been made on a scale and depth never before experienced in human history by such large masses of people.
- 3. China is far from being a classless, communist society where labour is finally liberated. The Communist Party of China itself describes China as being in the first stage of socialism. The Danish Communist Party does not consider it its task to judge China, but notes that "socialism with Chinese characteristics" constitutes an effort to carry the people's revolution through to the end.
- 4. Today, there is no socialist bloc or alternative socialist world system. China therefore operates within the framework of the imperialist system and must realize its national development project within the framework of a capitalist world economy. This creates a wide range of contradictions and challenges. For this reason too, Chinese society is highly complex and contradictory.

 US imperialism and the imperialist bloc united around the US regard China as a systemic enemy. The Danish Communist Party is of the opinion that it is up to the Chinese workers and people to choose their own path towards the goal of a liberating revolution without foreign interference. The Danish Communist Party supports the One China policy. We condemn the imperialist bloc's interference in China's internal affairs, which violates its right to independence and national sovereignty.

- In today's world, China is working for détente, peace and development and is a counterweight to the transatlantic imperialist bloc.
- 7. The future of the Chinese revolution is not decided. The Danish Communist Party stands in solidarity with everything that moves this revolution forward. The future of China is not only important for the Chinese people and the Chinese working class, but for the peoples of the whole world.
